SE Europe's pivotal role in the realization of the energy union and diversity of energy supplies

The Eastern Mediterranean has seen renewed interest and bullishness in prospects for recovery of natural gas resources across the offshore Levantine basin. Recently signed MOUs between the respective governments and energy Ministries in Greece, Cyprus and Israel focuses attention on the possibility of realizing a new "energy triangle". Renewed interest in Aphrodite, development of Gulf of Kavala and Greece's potential role at the fulcrum of the energy triangle offers hope for future collaboration.

SE Europe is a key transit corridor for natural gas supplies not only for prospective offshore East Med supplies but also as the E.U. entry point for supplies through TANAP and the near east. All regional TSOs have projects in place for interconnectivity (TAP, IAP, Vertical Gas Corridor) that together move the region towards playing its part in the realization of the E.C.'s stated aim for energy union.

Questions remain however. Interconnector projects face obstacles of achieving completion, offshore resources are highly promising but need agreement on exploitation and attracting project financing remains a notable challenge to moving forward. The **Global Oil & Gas SE Europe and Mediterranean summit** gathers all regional stakeholders to discuss and debate the opportunities and challenges as this fundamental region develops ever increasing energy union.


